Jude 22 And have mercy on some, who are doubting; 23 save others, snatching them out of the fire; and on some have mercy with fear, hating even the garment polluted by the flesh.

## D. False teachers remind us that there can be false

Luke 6:46 "Why do you call Me, 'Lord, Lord,' and do not do what I say?
Matthew $15: 8$ 'THIS PEOPLE HONORS ME WITH THEIR LIPS, BUT THEIR HEART IS FAR AWAY FROM ME.
Titus 1:16 They profess to know God, but by their deeds they deny Him...
2 Peter 1:5 diligence, ... moral excellence, ... knowledge, 6 self-control... perseverance, and ... godliness, 7 ... brotherly kindness, and ... love. 8 For if these qualities are yours and are increasing, they render you neither useless nor unfruitful in the true knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. 9 For he who lacks these qualities is blind or short-sighted, having forgotten his purification from his former sins. 10 Therefore, brethren, be all the more diligent to make certain about His calling and choosing you; for as long as you practice these things, you will never stumble
