Seven Areas of Unity That Affect Our View of the Church
1. We Exist as One (v.4)
"One Body" = Eph 1:23, 2:16, 3:6, 4:4, 4:12, 4:16, 5:23, 5:30
We are all ONE group of people redeemed by Christ, awaiting His return
Philippians 1:12-18 » ¹⁵ Some, to be sure, are preaching Christ even from envy and strife, but some also from good will; ¹⁶ the latter do it out of love, knowing that I am appointed for the defense of the gospel; ¹⁷ the former proclaim Christ out of selfish ambition, rather than from pure motives, thinking to cause me distress in my imprisonment. ¹⁸ What then? Only that in every way, whether in pretense or in truth, Christ is proclaimed; and in this I rejoice, yes, and I will rejoice.
We are not in competition. And neither are we to be isolated.
Hebrews 10:24-25 » let us consider how to stimulate one another to love and good deeds, not forsaking our own assembling together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another; and all the more as you see the day drawing near.
